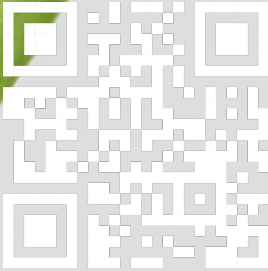


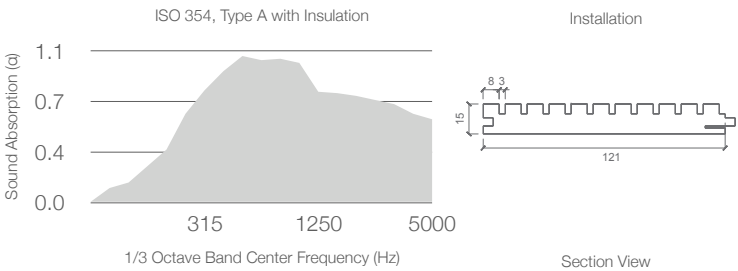

Timberix™ Grooved panels reduce echoes by trapping and diffracting sound in grooves and perforations. Sound passing through perforations is absorbed by an acoustic substrate such as fibreglass or mineral wool, reducing reverberation. Smaller grooves attenuate high frequencies, larger grooves control low frequencies.
